The Elmore County 4-H Educational Leaders Council is inviting all high school senior 4-H members to complete the following application for an educational scholarship.

The number of scholarships and the amounts awarded will be as follows:

No more than 50% of available funds to the top applicant, and no less than 10% of available funds to any other applicants. Depending on the number of applicants and available money each year, not all applicants are guaranteed a scholarship.

### Eligibility

1. Applicant must be a current 4-H member in Elmore County, Idaho, and complete their project.
2. Applicant must use money to further one's own education. (i.e. one, two, or four year program)

### Requirements

1. Applicant must complete the Scholarship Application.
2. Write an essay highlighting your entire 4-H career.

The essay needs to include:

- x Personal benefits you received from your experiences.
- x Your most rewarding or satisfying experiences
- x The experiences that taught you the most.
