Students enrolling in either academic or vocational programs will be considered, including production agriculture, agri-business, agricultural engineering or any other field related to agriculture.

Scholarship selection is based on need, achievement record, personal qualifications, and other leadership activities. The selection committee represents the MCGPA, financial institutions and the Women in Agriculture. Winners will be announced at the annual awards assembly of Minidoka County High School in May. Scholarship money will be available at the beginning of the recipient's second semester (term) of his/her freshman year, providing that the recipient maintained a grade point average of 2.0 and has carried a minimum of 12 credits during the first semester (term) and proof of registration for the second semester (term).

Scholarship must be requested prior to the beginning of the second semester (term), this date must be within three years of when the scholarship was awarded.

The amount of this award will be determined each year by the Minidoka County Grain Producers Board of Directors and will be announced each year.

<u>Letters of Recommendation</u>: Include at least two letters of recommendation from youth advisors commenting on academic and vocational leadership ability as well as character and financial need. (10%)
