## Barley Thrips Biology and Control

**The barley thrips** (*Limothrips denticornis* Haliday) is a newly identified pest in Idaho. It has caused economic damage only in barley but occurs in other winter grains, in spring wheat, and in early spring grasses. Although barley thrips are present on
