The USDA Harmonized GAP audit was developed as part of the Produce GAP Harmonization Initiative, an industriven effort to create food safety GAP standards and audit checklists for parevest and posharvest operations. The Initiative is a collaborative effort on the part of growers, shippers, produce buyers, audit organizations, and government agencies, including USDA. The USDA Harmonized GAP audit, in keeping with the Initiative's goals, is a single audit that is applicable to all fresh produce commodities, all sizes of of arm operations, and all regions in the United States.
