## **Key Messages**

- x Idaho ranked 49in active physicians per capita (20)18daho had approximately 3,200 physicians in 2021, with about 300 openings per year from physician turnover.
- x There has been recent expansion of medical education programs and there are plans to expand further the number of residency and fellowship programs.
- x In 2020, Idaho's health care sector paid \$5.3 billion in wages and benefits and supported 91,511 total direct jobs.
- x Total Idaho gross health care spending in 2014 (the most recent year available) was \$10.8 billion, the equivalent of 17.6% of Idahogsoss state poduct (GSP).
- x Annual Idaho per capita health care expenditures were \$62924 the most recent year available.
